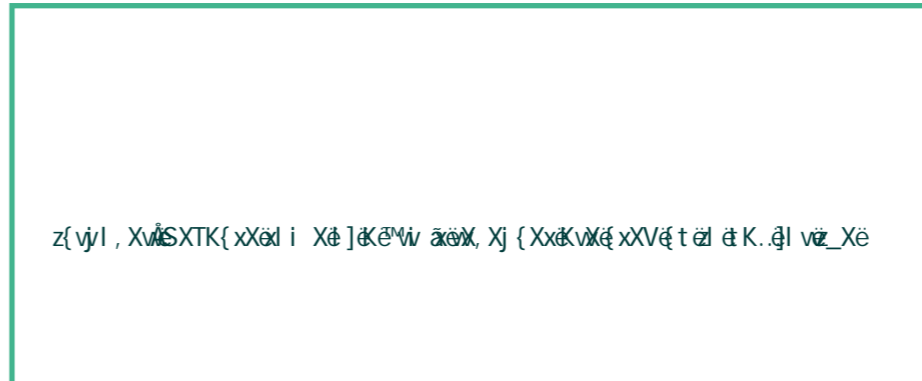


The University of Exeter is an important part of the UK economy, supporting economic output of almost **£1.6 billion** and contributing **£900 million** to UK GDP in 2020/21.
